



## Adeline Floy

July 7, 1914 - November 28, 2023

Adeline (Pesik) Floy, 109, of Clear Lake and formerly of Thornton, passed away peacefully under the care of St. Croix Hospice at the Oakwood Care Center on Tuesday, November 28, 2023. A Rosary Service will be held at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, December 4, 2023, at St. Patrick Catholic Church, 1001 Ninth Ave S, Clear Lake with visitation 9:30 a.m. until the Mass of Christian Burial at 10:30 a.m. with Father Josh Link officiating. 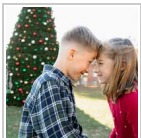
