Sunday school as well as serving on committees. She was also a member of the Williams American Legion Auxiliary for many years.

While raising her family, Adeline always had a large garden. Every year she canned and froze many vegetables. She was a great seamstress, cook and baker. In the later years she enjoyed reading and spent many hours working on her crossword puzzles. Spending time with her family and friends was very important to Adeline. Her greatest joy was her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. She will be greatly missed by all.

Adeline is survived by her daughters, Janet Kinney of Iowa Falls, Iowa, Diane Caruth of Stanhope, Iowa and Aileen (Duane) Bryant of St. Anthony, Iowa; ten grandchildren; nineteen great-grandchildren and six great-great grandchildren; two sisters in-law; one brother in-law and many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Harry; son, Jim Hudspith; two infant sons; five sisters and two brothers.


