Albert Viehmeyer, 92, of Hampton, passed away Saturday, November 12, 2022 at MercyOne North Iowa Hospice House in Mason City. A public visitation will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m., Thursday, November 17 at Counsell Woodley Funeral Home in Hampton. Burial will take place at a later date. Counsell Woodley Funeral Home of Hampton is caring for Albert and his family.

Albert "Al" Viehmeyer was born May 4, 1930, in Quincy, Illinois, to Albert and Freda (Rathbun) Viehmeyer. He served as a member of the United States Marine Corps during the Korean War from 1952 - 1955. He was awarded a Purple Heart for his service. After returning from Korea he moved to Hampton to help his parents with their farm. Al married Lou Ann Mosher on June 4, 1955, in Latimer. While he lived in Hampton Al also worked at the Ferris Nursery and the Hampton Feed Mill.

He moved to California in 1966. He worked for A.M.F. Voit, and then Orange County Teachers Credit Union until his retirement. Following his retirement Al moved back to Hampton in 1993.

In his free time Al enjoyed gardening, bowling, fishing, hunting, scuba diving, picapart, and shopping. He was also a 'car nut' - specifically antiques. He owned a '41 Ford pickup and a '55 Ford F100.

Al is survived by his children Denise (Manuel) Guajardo, William (Catherine) Viehmeyer, and Nanette (Jerry) Huisman; grandchildren, Rachelle, Jason, Jacob, Crystal, Barbara, and Belle, two great grandchildren, and one great-great grandchild.

He was preceded in death by his wife, his parents, and his brother Russell Viehmeyer.
