Bazetta Jane (Reints) Kew, 80, of Sheffield, Iowa, passed away Thursday, November 26, 2020, at the Sheffield Care Center. She was born on May 13, 1940, in a house near Ackley, to John and Susie (Nevenhoven) Reints. Bazetta grew up and attended school in Ackley. She loved telling people about her being from Ackley and how her dad was the chief of police in Ackley from the 1950's to early 60's, before he passed away. Bazetta would always attend Ackley Sauerkraut Days, parades in Ackley, as well as parades in surrounding towns. Bazetta met John Kew at the skating rink in Iowa Falls. They were married on December 16, 1960, in Ackley and found their home on a farm near Chapin. She worked as a telephone operator before and after her and John were married and until their children were born. This union brought two boys John Jr. and Craig. Bazetta enjoyed gardening and garden decorations. She had over 150 plants in her greenhouse room. Bazetta also enjoyed crocheting blankets, working on puzzles and word find books, and watching Jeopardy and Wheel of Fortune.
