Berton "Paul" Luebbers, 88, of Greene, Iowa, passed away Sunday, October 16, 2022, at his home. Public visitation will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m., Thursday, October 20, at Counsell Woodley Funeral Home in Greene, with Rosary at 7 p.m. Funeral mass will take place at 10:30 a.m., Friday, October 21, at St. Mary Catholic Church in Greene.
