Beulah Hearn, 90, of Dumont, passed away Friday, June 28, 2024, at Franklin General Hospital. Memorial service will be held 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, July 23, at New Hope United Methodist Church, Dumont with Pastor Dennis Burns officiating. Interment will be at the Dumont Cemetery. Visitation will be 1 hour prior to the service at the church. Woodley Funeral Home and Crematory, Dumont is caring for Beulah and her family.

Beulah Irene Hearn was born May 8, 1934, at Dumont, daughter of Henry and Viola (Hanawalt) Miller. She graduated from Dumont High School and NIACC.

She was a piano player, teacher, and singer. She drove the special needs van for Dumont School. She is remembered as a great cook and baker, but most notably being a mom, grandma, and great grandma.
