Billy Eugene Miller, 80, of Hampton, passed away Saturday, December 5, 2020, at MercyOne North Iowa Medical Center in Mason City. Bill attended Hampton Consolidated School and graduated in 1958. He joined the Iowa National Guard during his junior year of high school March 2, 1957 until March 1, 1960. Bill then joined the Army Reserve in Mason City March 2, 1960 and attended Non-Com Officer training school at Ft. Carson, Colorado, in December 1962. He was honorably discharged from the Army Reserve February 28, 1965. He started farming with his father when he was 14 years old. Bill also helped the neighbors milk cows before and after school.
