Byrd Robbins, 94, of Iowa Falls, passed away Sunday, May 8, 2022 at Scenic Manor. Memorial services will be 11:00 AM on Thursday, May 12, 2022 at the Bethany Lutheran Church in Iowa Falls. She will be laid to rest with a family graveside inurnment at the Union Cemetery in Iowa Falls. Visitation will be from 10:30 AM until service time on Thursday at the church.
