Dallas Diemer, 78, of Iowa Falls, passed away Saturday, October 26, 2019 at Hansen Family Hospital. Funeral services will be 10:30 AM Tuesday, October 29, 2019 at the First United Methodist Church in Iowa Falls. He will be laid to rest at the Union Cemetery.
