Travis Berg will be officiating. Darrel Aaron Borcharding, 90, of Hampton, Iowa, died on Tuesday, December 22, 2015, at the Muse Norris Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mason City. He was born October 21, 1925, at the farm home of his parents, Henry F. and Emma (Pralle) Borcharding. Darrel was baptized November 27, 1925, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Latimer, by Pastor E. H. Grummer. He attended Country School and St. Paul's Lutheran School in Latimer and was confirmed April 2, 1939, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church by Pastor E. H. Grummer. He lived his confirmation verse Galatians 6:9, "Let us not grow weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not". He was a lifetime member of St. Paul's, Latimer, and served in many offices and committees. He graduated from Latimer High School in 1943 and started farming. He was inducted into the U.S. Navy and served on a destroyer in 1945 and 1946. Darrel was honorably discharged August 3, 1946, and returned to farming. On November 25, 1950, he married Norma Stratmann. They were blessed with four children, Jean, Kay, Tim and Steve. He continued farming while also being employed by Franklin County ASCS office, W. R. Grace Co. Feed and Fertilizer division, Latimer State Bank and Morgan Drive Away delivering Winnebago's. Darrel served on the Coulter Creamery Board, Farmers Grain and Coal Co. Board of Coulter and County 4-H Committee. He was a Little League coach, on the Coulter Fire Dept. and served as Hamilton Twp. clerk for 46 years. He enjoyed sports, golf, cards, watching his childrens, grandchildrens and great-grandchildrens events, working and helping others. He and Norma enjoyed spending the winters in Texas.
