



## Elaine R. Egede

February 14, 1930 - June 1, 2017

Elaine R. Egede, 87, of Hampton, passed away Thursday, June 1, 2017, at the Rehabilitation Center of Hampton. Elaine Ruth Petersen Egede was born on a farm south of Coulter on February 14, 1930. She was the daughter of Walter and Hannah (Jensen) Petersen. They moved from the farm to Latimer and lived in several houses there. Elaine was confirmed and baptized at Nazareth Lutheran Church, where she attended services, belonged to Ladies Aid, sang in the church choir and was a Sunday school teacher. Elaine attended grade school in Latimer and graduated from Franklin Consolidated in 1948. After graduation, she worked in the Latimer Café for several years and then worked in the Latimer Bank. Elaine was married to Halvor Egede on August 26, 1967, at the Nazareth Lutheran Church in Coulter. Halvor and Elaine then moved to a farm where they lived after they were married. She helped Halvor farm, had a large garden and flower beds and they both enjoyed the farm work. Elaine became a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in 1968, where she was active in Ladies Aid and helped make quilts with other women. She also taught Sunday school and worked at St. John's during vacation bible school. Elaine was preceded in death by her parents Walter and Hannah Petersen, her brother Kenneth Petersen, sister Mildred Mowell and her husband Raymond, sister Helen Haupt and her husband Bernard.
