Glen "Ed" Dougan, 83, of Bradford, passed away Monday, December 27, 2021 at his home. Funeral services will be 1:00 PM Thursday, December 30, 2021 at the Counsell Woodley Funeral Home in Iowa Falls. Ed (Glen Edward) Dougan passed away December 27, 2021 at his home in Bradford, Iowa. He was born November 27, 1938 on his family's farm in Iowa Falls to Darlene (Riley) and Horace Dougan.
