



## Glenn Alvin Futrell

Glenn Alvin Futrell, 90, of Hampton, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, December 28, 2016, at the North Memorial Medical Center in Robbinsdale, Minnesota. He was born on November 29, 1926 in Clarkson, IA. Glenn was the son of William and Nona (Bartholomew) Futrell. He was united in marriage to Aleta (Baldwin) on August 19, 1947 in Janesville, IA.
