



## Gordon Schrock

August 8, 1945 - April 3, 2025

Gordon Schrock, 79, of Dumont, passed away Thursday, April 3, 2025, at Franklin General Hospital in Hampton. Funeral services will be held at 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, April 8, 2025, at Faith Baptist Church in Hampton. Visitation will be held one hour prior to the service at the church. Gordon will be laid to rest at the Harlan Cemetery in rural Dumont. Woodley Funeral Home of Hampton is caring for Gordon and his family.

Gordon Glen Schrock was born August 8, 1945, in rural Dumont, son of Galen and Alice (Delp) Schrock. He was the youngest of four children.
