



## Hanna Amkea Tjaden Johnson

September 13, 1925 - September 5, 2014

Hanna Tjaden Johnson, 88, of Allison, Iowa, passed away Friday, September 5, 2014, at the Rehabilitation Center of Allison in Allison, Iowa. She was born on September 13, 1925, in Mittegrossefehn, Germany, to Jacob and Antje (Tjaden) Ennen. Hanna attended schools in Mittegrossefehn, Germany. She was married to Souke "Sam" Tjaden on June 26, 1951, in Germany, he preceded her in death; she then married Harry Johnson on March 2, 1968, in Greene, Iowa.
