Hazel Harriet Juhl Troe, 93, of Hampton, Iowa, passed away Tuesday, February 2, 2016, at Franklin Country View Nursing Facility in Hampton, Iowa. She was born on June 5, 1922, in Burchinal, Iowa, to Nick and Bertha (Hadsell) Juhl. Hazel attended rural schools in Rockwell and Northwood, moving to Northwood in the third grade. She graduated from High School in 1940. Hazel was united in marriage to Arnold Troe on January 18, 1941. While Arnold served in the Navy, Hazel taught country school. After Arnold's tour was complete, they began farming near Thornton. Several years later, they moved to a farm near Hampton and lived there until retiring in 1977, when they moved into Hampton. She worked for the local grocery store and also assisted many people transporting them to appointments, financial help and just being a friend. Hazel was a long time active member of the St. Paul Lutheran Church in Hampton until such time it became too difficult for her to get around. She moved to the assisted living in Hampton, when life started taking a toll on her and in April 2012, moved to the nursing home. Hazel is survived by her son Carroll and wife Joan Troe of Aplington, granddaughters Tiffany and husband Randy Burk of Glastonbury, Connecticut and Ainsley and husband Kurt Brungardt of Vail, Iowa, great-granddaughters Jordan, Alec and Peyton Brungardt and Gabriella, Grace and Rylee Burk. She was preceded in death by her parents Nick and Bertha, husband Arnold in 1995, brother Delbert Juhl and sisters Charlotte Luick, Cleo Gullickson, Edna Hansen, Helen Johnson, Phyllis Ballandby and Esther Juhl.
