June 16, 1924 - May 24, 2016

Henrietta Card, 91, of Allison, Iowa, passed away Tuesday, May 24, 2016, at the Rehabilitation Center of Allison in Allison, Iowa. Henrietta Kampmann was born June 16, 1924, to Friedrich and Harmke (Freudenberg) Kampmann in Ostfriesland, Germany. At the age of 3 ½ months, she along with her parents and her 3 year old sister (Almuth) Alma started their journey from Aurich, Germany to America. They left in mid-October 1924 setting sail on the ship "The USS Columbus," and arrived on Ellis Island, New York on October 24, 1924. They traveled by train to relatives in Butler County, Iowa, where her family settled and she grew up. Henrietta attended rural country schools in Butler County. She was united in marriage to Clifton Card on October 12, 1945, at St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church - Vilmar. Henrietta helped her husband with farm work and later enjoyed working with racing horses. She had her own job of taking care of laying hens and collecting eggs, while living on the farm. Henrietta enjoyed painting and her most special activity was working hand-n-hand with Clifton. She was a member of St. James Lutheran Church in Allison, where she was active in Bible study, taught vacation bible school and was active in women's circle.
