James "Jim" Allen Koenen, 79, of Hampton, passed away Friday, September 6, 2024, at MercyOne North Iowa Medical Center in Mason City. Jim was born September 16, 1944, in Franklin County, Iowa, son of Pete and Esther (Blau) Koenen. He grew up on the family farm near Latimer and graduated from CAL Community School, class of 1963. Jim furthered his education at Universal Trade School in Omaha, Nebraska, studying auto body and fender work. He then served in the National Guard for 6 years.

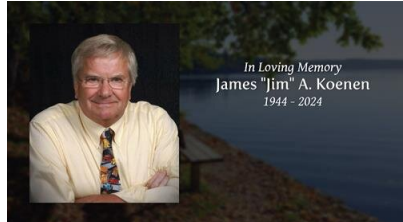
