John Ivan Thompson, 94, of Hampton, passed away Wednesday, July 31, 2019, peacefully with family by his side. He was born on January 5, 1925, in Lamont, Iowa, to George Levi and Iva May (Allen) Thompson. John graduated from Lamont High School and after spent a short time in the Navy. Then, he attended Iowa State University, where he was an active fraternity brother of Alpha Gamma Rho, and earned his Bachelor's degree in Agronomy.
