



## Kenneth Paul Goetsch

January 15, 1936 - November 4, 2023

Kenneth Goetsch, 87, died Saturday, November 4, 2023, at the Iowa Specialty Hospital – Clarion. Memorial service will be held 11:00 a.m., Saturday, November 11, 2023 at Immanuel United Church of Christ, Latimer. Private family burial will be at the Hampton Cemetery.

Kenneth Paul Goetsch was born January 15, 1936, in Minnesota, a son of Emil and Erna (Raaf) Goetsch. He was baptized in the Lutheran church on March 8 of that year and graduated from Madison, Minnesota High School with the class of 1953. Ken served in the U.S. Navy being honorably discharged in 1957.

On August 22, 1959, Ken was united in marriage with Katherine ‘Leyla’ Chrtrt at Canby, Minnesota. They lived in Minnesota until 1972 when they moved their young family to Iowa, settling in Latimer.
