Larry Montandon, 78, of Dows, passed away Tuesday, October 25, 2022 at his home. He will be laid to rest with a private family graveside inurnment at the Fairview Cemetery in Dows. Counsell Woodley Funeral Home and Cremation Services of Iowa Falls is caring for Larry and his family.
