Lois Uhlenhopp, 81, of Aplington, Iowa, passed away Monday, February 20, 2023, at UnityPoint Health - Allen Hospital in Waterloo.

A public visitation will take place from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m., Friday, February 24, 2023, at Counsell Woodley Funeral Home in Allison, Iowa, followed by a brief prayer service at 7 p.m. A public graveside service will be held at 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, March 1, 2023, at Pleasant View Cemetery near Aplington, Iowa.

Lois was born May 13, 1941, to parents William and Jesse (Studnicka) Hassman. She graduated from high school in 1958. Later that same year, on November 11, she was united in marriage to Donald Uhlenhopp in Cedar Falls, Iowa. To this union two children were born: Carol and Craig. Lois and Don made their home and raised their family in Aplington. Lois was saved at Hitesville Gospel Hall in September of 1963. While they raised their own children, the couple also took in and cared for 21 foster children. The family loved taking trips all over in their camper.

She worked as a CNA at the nursing home in Aplington, and later at the nursing home in Ackley. She also worked as an in-home caretaker later in life. Lois was a kind and caring person who always looked out for the needs of those around her before her own. She was a fantastic mother, friend, and caretaker. She would always listen to you and hear you out, all without judging

you - not even for a second.

Lois is survived by her children, Carol Santee and Craig Uhlenhopp, grandchildren; Carlye Santee and Zachariah Kastner, great-grandchildren; Natas Hildebrant, Ashton Kastner and Elijah Kastner, sister Bonnie (Clarence) Swieter, sister-in-law Mavis Hassman, and numerous foster children, nieces, nephews, friends and extended family.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her brother William Hassman, and by her unborn son Donnie.
