Louise Junker, 94, of Hampton, Iowa, passed away November 22, 2013, at the Rehabilitation Center - Hampton. She was born September 4, 1919, near Bristow, Butler, County, Iowa, to William and Minna (Gobel) Friedrichs. Louise attended Benezette No. 6 country school and Aredale High School.
