



## Margaret "Marge" Ann Hemmes

Margaret "Marge" Ann Hemmes, 89, of Hampton, passed away Saturday, April 22, 2023, at the Sheffield Care Center. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m., Saturday, April 29, 2023, at First Congregational United Church of Christ in Hampton. Visitation will be held one hour prior to the service at the church on Saturday. Burial will take place in the Hampton Cemetery. Marge was born May 28, 1933, in Dumont, daughter of Jasper and Allie (Folkerts) Kriens. She was the thirteenth of their fifteen children. Marge graduated from Dumont High School, class of 1951.
