Mark Meineke, 62, of Popejoy, passed away Friday, January 6, 2023 at Hansen Family Hospital. A memorial visitation will be held from 5-7 PM on Friday, January 13, 2023 at the Counsell Woodley Funeral Home in Iowa Falls. He will be laid to rest with a private family graveside inurnment at the St. Mary's Catholic Cemetery in Williams. 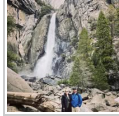
