*My hope and prayer is that they find a cure for this horrible disease that has sadly affected your family and taken our loved ones way too soon.*

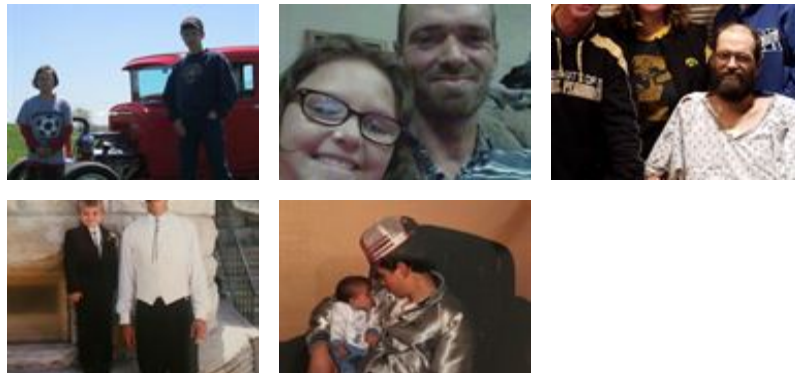
