Matt Halladay, 57, of Alden, passed away Sunday, December 9, 2018 at Hansen Family Hospital in Iowa Falls after a battle with lung cancer. A time of fellowship will be held on Thursday, December 13, 2018 from 3:30 PM to 5:30 PM followed by a memorial service at 5:30 PM at Bethany Lutheran Church in Iowa Falls. A light supper will be served at the church following the memorial service. Private family burial will be held at a later date.
