Mitchell Dean Dralle, 51, of Parkersburg, passed away Tuesday, December 17, 2024, at his home. Visitation will be held from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., Sunday, December 22, 2024, at Trinity Reformed Church in Allison. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m., Monday, December 23, 2024, at Trinity Reformed Church in Allison. Mitchell will be laid to rest in the Allison Cemetery. Woodley Funeral Home of Allison is caring for Mitchell and his family.

Mitchell was born May 26, 1973, in Tama County, son of Richard and Sharon (Ulfers) Dralle. He graduated from Allison-Bristow High School, class of 1991. Mitchell furthered his education at the University of Iowa, receiving his bachelor's degree in Therapeutic Recreation.
