Patricia Jo Smith, 68, of Urbana, passed away Friday, February 7, 2025, at UnityPoint Health - St. Luke's Hospital in Cedar Rapids. Funeral services will be held at 11:00 a.m., Thursday, February 13, 2025, at Woodley Funeral Home in Greene. Visitation will be held one hour prior to the service at the funeral home.
