Patrick Marshall "Pat" Feltus, 84, of Allison, passed away Saturday, August 23, 2025 at Maple Manor in Aplington, with family by his side. Funeral services will be 10:30 AM Wednesday, August 27, 2025 at St. James Lutheran Church in Allison. Patrick will be laid to rest at the Allison Cemetery. Visitation will be one hour prior at the church. Woodley Funeral Home of Allison is caring for Pat and his family.

Pat was the son of Robert Dale Feltus and Siena Margaret (DeBower) Feltus. He graduated from Allison-Bristow High School and attended Wartburg College in Waverly.

Pat married Ruth Ann Endelman on November 3, 1961. He was a lifelong member of St. James Lutheran Church in Allison. Pat was a proud union Certified Master Mason and bricklayer.
