Paul David Ringenberg, 74, of Bettendorf, Iowa, passed away peacefully in his home on Saturday, September 14, 2024. Paul will be laid to rest with a graveside service and burial at 11:00 AM Saturday, September 21, 2024 at the Oak Wood Cemetery in Ackley. A private family viewing will be held at the Woodley Funeral Home in Iowa Falls.

Paul was born November 12, 1949 in Springfield, Missouri to Paul and Aline Ringenberg. He attended Topeka High School, graduating with the class of 1967. He went on to receive his Bachelor's Degree and his Master's Degree in Music from Washburn University. He played the cello for the Topeka Symphony Orchestra. He attended many baseball camps growing up and played the position of catcher in high school, college and minor league AA ball. Paul later joined the Navy and served a tour at sea during the Vietnam war.

His wife Diane's passing in 2011 was very hard on him.

During his retirement, Paul loved his grandkids, his beloved dogs, and working on his fishing boat and taking it out on the lake. Paul was a God-fearing, hardworking, family-loving man that will be very missed by those that knew him.

Paul is survived by his son, Eric (Karah) Ringenberg of Ackley, Iowa; his daughter, Amanda (Adam) Clary of Johnston, Iowa; grandchildren: Evelyn Clary (5), Milo Clary (3), Marshall Ringenberg (2), Wyatt Ringenberg (10 months) and unborn grandchild, baby Ringenberg, expected to arrive March 2025.
