Reece Adams, 87, of Iowa Falls, passed away Friday, January 6, 2023 at his Iowa Falls residence, under the care of Care Initiatives Hospice. Reece C. Adams was born on May 23, 1935 to Alex Adam Groff and Pauline Christine Weitzel in Mason City, Iowa. He graduated high school in 1953.

After high school, Reece started working for the railroad. He then moved to Clear Lake where he worked for his father-in-law's Ford dealership in the parts department. He finished out his career with 30 years at Luiken & Sons in Steamboat Rock.

favorite sport.
