Richard Terveer, 93, of Iowa Falls, passed away Monday, July 19, 2021 at Hansen Family Hospital, under the care of Care Initiatives Hospice. Funeral services will be 10:30 AM Saturday, July 24, 2021 at the First United Methodist Church in Iowa Falls. He will be laid to rest at the Northlawn Memory Gardens at a later date. Visitation will be from 4-7 PM on Friday, July 23 at the Woodley Funeral Home. Woodley Funeral Home, LLC of Iowa Falls is caring for Dick and his family.

Dick was born to Henry John Terveer and Luella Mae (Collins) Terveer on January 10, 1928 in Alden, Iowa. He was the ninth born of ten children. Dick completed the eighth grade and the first semester of ninth grade at the country school in Wilke, Iowa. Much of his education was self-taught – there was not anything he couldn't figure out or fix.

Dick was a past member of the Elks, the Moose, the VFW, and the American Legion. He was also a member of the First United Methodist Church in Iowa Falls where he was recently baptized when he was 90 years old.

In March of 1946 Dick enlisted in the U.S. Navy and completed his basic training in San Diego, California. He later was shipped overseas to Saipan, Japan where he served until November 1946 when he was medically discharged.

On October 30, 1948 Dick married Irene Ziesman and to this union three children were born – Gary Lee, Sherri Lynn, and Lori Kay. Irene passed away on April 24, 1969 in Popejoy, Iowa at the age of 41.

On November 20 of 1969 Dick married Kay Ann Hayes in Omaha, Nebraska and to this union two sons were born – Bret Shannon, and Brandon Jade (B.J.).

Dick was an auto mechanic for most of his life – he was the service manager at Kinsey Chevrolet, he owned and operated Dick's Hiway Service Texaco Station in Iowa Falls for many years where he specialized in automatic transmissions. After his business was sold, he operated his own business out of his garage in rural Hubbard. He worked in sales at Dale Howard Chevrolet, was the service manager at Beckman Ford, and was a service technician at Magic Muffler. After retirement he enjoyed being an attendant at Super Wash and keeping his beloved red Chevy truck clean.

Dick loved many things, his guardian angel Kay, his five children, his eight grandchildren, his six great grandchildren, deer hunting with Grandpa Floyd in Wyoming, traveling to NASCAR races at the Kansas Speedway in the race van and rooting for Dale Junior, camping, boating, fishing with his sons-in-law and special friend Dave Stanley, vacations to Okoboji, tractor rides with his relatives, mowing the yard with his John Deere, driving his Chevy pickup, and working on cars. Some of his hobbies included drag racing, collecting knives, having a garden, and collecting Texaco memorabilia. But most of all he loved spending time with his family.

Dick is survived by his wife of 52 years, Kay; daughter, Sherri (Terry) of Iowa Falls, daughter, Lori (Doug) of Jewell; son, Bret of Hampton; former daughter-in-law, Karen; son, B.J. (Ed) of Barnes City; grandchildren, Jessica (Scott) of

Poland, Maine, Megan (Ed) of Fort Dodge, Ryan (Trisha) of Ames, Brianna (Austin) of Grundy Center, Dylan of Alden, Zach of Ankeny, Alesha of Webster City, Alivia of Iowa Falls and great granddaughters: Zoie, Ava, Katelynn, Emma, Hailee, and Karsyn. He was preceded in death by his parents, Henry and Luella; his first wife, Irene; his six brothers: Jim, Bill, Bob, Merle, Wayne and Clarence; sisters, Laura, Florence and Clara; daughter-in-law, Vicky and his firstborn son, Gary.
