



## Robert "Bob" Palo

Robert Palo, 90, of Iowa Falls, passed away Thursday, October 17, 2019 at Scenic Manor. A memorial visitation will be from 1-3 PM on Saturday, October 26, 2019 at the Woodley Funeral Home. He will be laid to rest with a private family graveside service and military honors at the Alden Cemetery, following visitation. Robert William (Bob) Palo was born in Blairsburg, Iowa to William and Gladys (Miller) Palo on June 15, 1929. He was an American Legion member in Alden for over 60 years.

Bob is survived by Jean, his wife of 62 years; daughter, Rhonda (Michael) Hein of Madison, Wisconsin; daughter, LaRae Palo of Lafayette, Colorado; sister, Patricia (Dean) Duit of Iowa Falls, Iowa and grandchildren, Whitney and Brooke Hein and Grace, Lane and Denver Palo. He was preceded in death by his parents and brother, Merle.
