Rob Dietz, 54, of Hampton, passed away Wednesday, October 11, 2023, as the result of an auto accident. Visitation will be held from 5 p.m.– 8 p.m., Friday, October 27 at Trinity Lutheran Church, Hampton. Memorial services will be held at the church on Saturday, October 28 at 11 a.m. Interment is planned at St. Paul Lutheran Cemetery, Latimer at a future date. 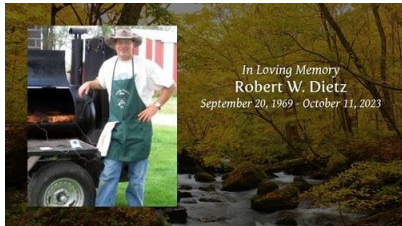
