Ronald King Ellingson, 72, of Cedar Falls, passed away Friday, June 21, 2024 at MercyOne Waterloo Medical Center, under the care of Cedar Valley Hospice and surrounded by his loving family. A private family graveside inurnment will be held at the Friends Cemetery. Woodley Funeral Home and Crematory of Iowa Falls is caring for Ron and his family.

Born on April 24, 1952, in Mason City, Ron was a dedicated family man and a proud Navy veteran.
