Ronald Lettow, 77, of Iowa Falls, passed away Thursday, June 14, 2018 at Mercy North Iowa in Mason City. Funeral services will be 10:30 am Monday, June 18, 2018 at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Iowa Falls. Burial will be at the Alden Cemetery.
