Sandra Kay Fellmer of Hampton passed away July 11, 2011 at the Franklin General Hospital in Franklin County, Iowa. She was born September 23, 1939 in Waterloo, Iowa to John "Jack" Ramsell and Margaret Hunter Ramsell. The union did not survive WWII, and in 1947 Margaret remarried. Her husband of 35 years, Frank Mahncke, was a Hampton native and returned with his new family back to the Hampton area. Sandra graduated from Hampton High School in 1958. Moving back to Waterloo, Iowa with her father's family, she joined numerous relatives employed at Northwestern Bell, or Ma Bell, as it was known. In 1959 she married Charles F. Fellmer, to which two children were born, Todd and Victoria. Sandra stayed 29 years with the phone company, moving often to where the jobs were, before retiring and returning to Hampton. Her greatest hobbies were buying, selling, collecting, and generally junking around North Iowa. Sandra also enjoyed her membership to the Trinity Lutheran Church in Hampton, Iowa. Sandra is survived by her son, Todd (Genie) Fellmer of Englewood, Colorado and daughter Victoria, of Hampton, Iowa.
