Vernon Eugene Kampman, 72 of Allison, Iowa, died Sunday April 29th, 2012 at Covenant Hospital in Waterloo due to complications from Parkinson's disease. Vernon was born August 13th, 1939 in rural Butler County to Chris and Irene (Christopherson) Kampman. He graduated from Allison High School in 1957. A daughter Denise Junker and her husband Tim of Allison, a son Donavon and his wife Ruth (Seehusen) of Allison. Four grandchildren Michelle (Murph) Washington of Mason City and Matthew Heuer (Tiffany) of Mason City and Kayla Kampman and Kyle Kampman of Allison. And two great-grandchildren Isaiah and Tyce Washington. One brother Kenneth of Cedar Falls. He was preceded in death
