Virgil L. Arends, 63, of Dumont, IA, passed away August 23, 2016, at the Muse-Norris Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mason City, IA, after a hard-fought battle with cancer. He was born October 7, 1952, to Siebert and Eva (Etzen) Arends in Hampton, IA. He married Terry Bakke on June 26, 1976 at the Little Brown Church and she survives.
